Chair Danyelle Harp reports; the 2018 NWCC Directories will not be available for the banquet this year but the 68-page directory has new advertisers and more pages. The directory will be done March 1 and will be distributed to the clubs and mailed to the membership.

NWCC Website, Cathy Glover reports; they will have a new site this year and will include the directory cover and more pictures.

CHAMPS Chair Megan reports of several shows in the NWCC. Several clubs have shown interest in the program and Megan presented this program to the board. Megan plans on talking to the Show and Contest committee at the APHA Convention to see if this could be expanded more at the national level.

Director Guidelines have been updated and sent to all National Directors.

The board discussed the Awards Chair Position/Job. There will be a \$50.00 shipping charge for each recipient if the awards are not picked up at the banquet.

2018 Year End Awards coordinator position was discussed. Brenda Wood and Kristi Duncan both were present and gave a presentation of what they could present for NWCC year-end awards. The Decision was tabled until an Email meeting among the Directors could take place after all clubs had time to take back to their clubs and vote for this position. Vote will take place on March 31, 2019 by messenger.
